1.0 CALL TO ORDER

<u>Chair Sampson</u> called a meeting of the Board of Directors of Astoria School District No. 1C, Clatsop County, to order at 6:15 P.M. on Wednesday, December 12, 2018 in the Astoria School District Boardroom.
